RO Plant Inauguration

To provide safe drinking water, Tata Power-DDL installed an RO Water Plant at Government Girls Senior Secondary School, Mukundpur, Burari on 25th Oct 2019. The inauguration was done by Mr. Sanjeev Jha (MLA - Burari) and Mr. Pramod Kumar (Deputy Director of Education) in the presence of Mr. Sanjay Banga (CEO, Tata Power-DDL) and other senior officials of the company. The RO plant will quench the thirst of 7,000 students of the school every day. This is an addition to the existing 71 such RO plants at educational institutions, JJ clusters and Delhi Metro Stations.

Arogya Project

Tata Power-DDL launched Project Arogya on 3rd Oct 2019 in Udham Singh Park, Wazirpur Industrial Area to curb the issue of existing malnutrition in children and expecting mothers residing in areas that come under its operation. Initially, the project is being supported by 6 Aanganwadi workers & NGO Eduquest and aims to create awareness about the need for a healthy diet and prevalence of malnutrition in children, pregnant & lactating women. The **Impact4Nutrition** platform is being utilized as the knowledge partner that provides various aids, capacity building and demo sessions along with toolkits for the beneficiaries.

Eye Care Camp

Tata Power-DDL organised a free eye care camp for the residents of Jahangirpuri on 18th Oct 2019 wherein 125 people of the nearby community between the age group of 50 to 70 years were given free eye check-up. Approximately 65 people were diagnosed with Cataract and 35 people were diagnosed with Eye Refraction issues. These patients were referred to Sant Parmanand Hospital, where they can access free treatment for Cataract and get free spectacles with the support of Tata Power-DDL. The rest of the patients were prescribed eye drops and regular medicines to ensure healthy eyesight.
